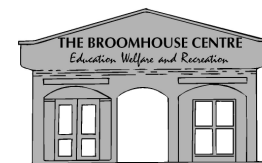
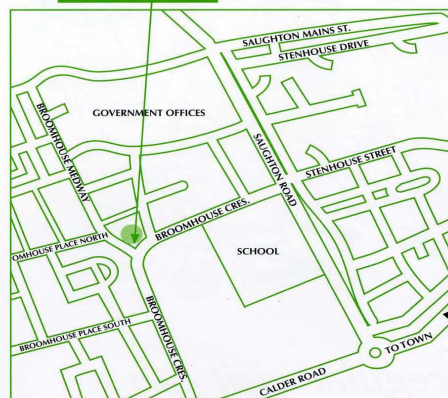


YOUNG CARERS SUPPORT GROUP
