**Day Service:** offers day care to older people with mild to moderate dementia

- Mondays & Thursdays, Broomhouse Centre / Wednesdays, Juniper Green; All the groups are small, offering only 9 or 10 places per day
- Refreshments on arrival, choice of hot meals at lunchtime, & blend of activities & outings, according to their preferences, abilities & needs
- Transport is provided with a trained escort, to & from the club
- The club aims to improve the quality of life for people with what can be a socially isolating condition, as well as supporting them to live in their own homes for as long as possible
- Members make a small contribution to the weekly costs; Break for Carers while clients are at the club. Referrals: from relatives/friends/ professionals

**Singing Group:** a safe, friendly & stimulating environment for people with dementia & carers

- Singing with the emphasis on enjoyment & fun, & an opportunity to meet others; meets on 1st & 3rd Tuesday of the month, 2.00pm – 4.00pm
